**Tennis Format:** Each club's Tournament Director has the option of modifying the tennis format but we recommend a round robin of at least 3 rotations, 8 game pro sets no Ad. All 8 games must be played in each round. A four person NFL team (2 subs optional for a total of 6 players) against another. Teams should wear attire to signify their football team represented, i.e. team colors, jersey, hat, etc.

**Football Format (Optional):** One tennis court shall be designed as a modified football field as shown on back. At least 2 teams are rotated to the football court where they get one practice in punting, passing and extra point kicking. Then each team member gets one chance to score in each of the three football skills. At the end, each team's total football score will be added to their total tennis score to obtain a winner in each division. There may be opportunities for post season playoffs for division winners against another tennis club in the area.

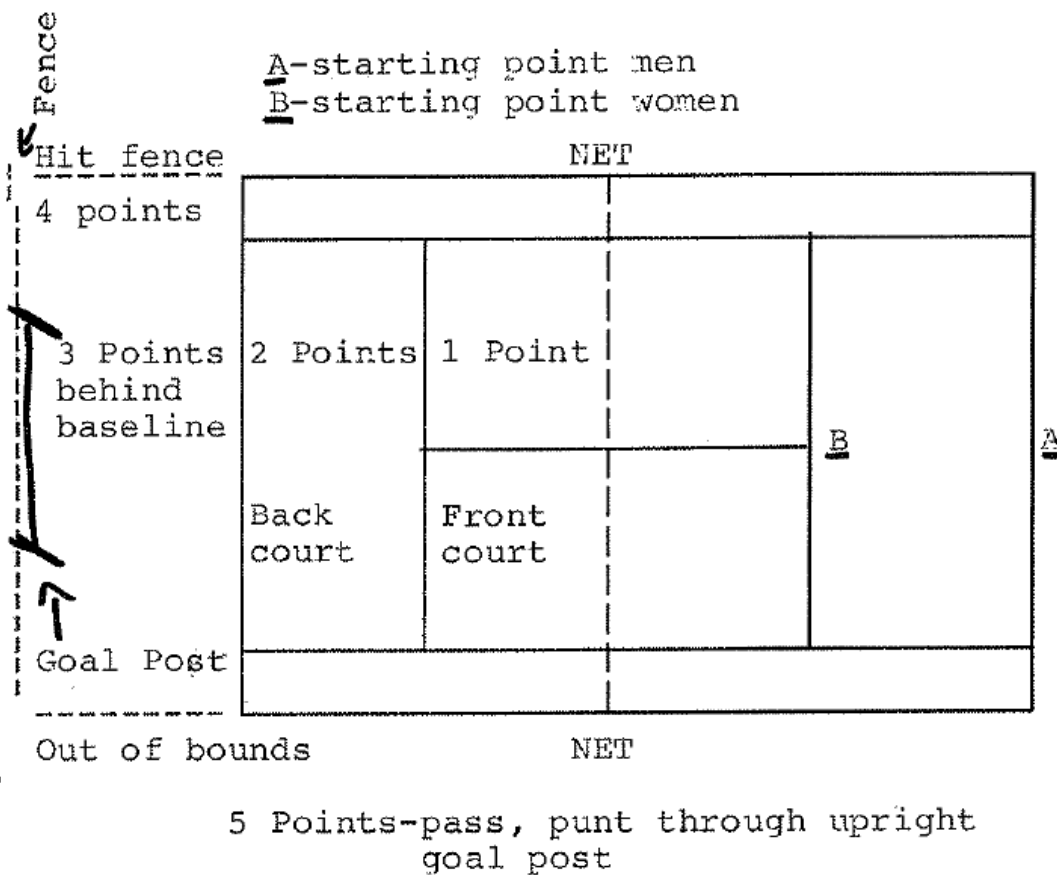
